THE COURT HEREBY ORDERS:

(1) No later than seven (7) days following the court's notification to the
 Commissioner of the commencement of the action, the plaintiff shall provide the United States

Attorney's Office for the Western District of Washington ("USAO-WDWA") with: (a) the
plaintiff's full name and (b) either the plaintiff's social security number or the Beneficiary Notice
Control Number ("BNC") of the hearing decision that the plaintiff wishes to appeal. This
identifying information is necessary for the Commissioner to obtain and produce the certified
administrative record. This information shall be provided to the USAO-WDWA either by email
to USAWAW.SSAClerk@usdoj.gov or delivery, by hand or mail, to "SSA Clerk Civil Division"
at 700 Stewart Street, Suite 5220, Seattle, WA 98101.

(2) The Commissioner is not required to file a Notice of Filing of the Certified
Administrative Record when the administrative record is filed in electronic format. Such notice
shall only be required in cases where the administrative record is filed in paper format.

(3) The effective date of this Order is October 23, 2024. The Court reserves the right to modify this order from time to time, or rescind the order entirely, as the Court determines necessary in light of experience.

(4) The Clerk of Court shall post a copy of this Order on the Court's website and shall distribute copies as the Clerk deems appropriate.
